Coyotes will eat anything they can catch including insects, birds, snakes, lizards, frogs, rabbits, and beavers. They will also eat plants such as grasses and berries.


Gray Fox

What does it eat?

Pygmy Rabbit



What does it eat?

The Pygmy Rabbits eats mostly sagebrush. But they will eat any green plant that is available.

Black-tailed Jackrabbit



What does it eat?

The Black-tailed Jackrabbit will eat grasses and leaves of shrubs.

Cliff Chipmunk



What does it eat?

The Cliff chipmunk mostly eats seeds and other plant materials. However, they will also eat small animals such as insects.

Great Basin Pocket Mouse



What does it eat?

This mouse will mostly eat seeds. Sometimes the pocket mouse will eat plants and insects.

American Beaver



What does it eat?

Beavers will eat leaves and the inner bark of trees and shrubs.

North American Porcupine



What does it eat?

The porcupine will eat a wide variety of plant material including the leaves, fruit, and seeds.


Elk

These bats eat a large number of beetles, moths, and other insects.


Pallid bat

American Kestral

This bird will just about anything it can catch. It will eat insects, small rodents, grasshoppers, beetles, spiders, mice, and birds.

Song Sparrow



What does it eat?

These birds eat seeds and berries. However, depending on the time of year they will also eat insects, grasshoppers, and spiders.

Pseudoscorpions



What does it eat?

This animal will eat small insects, larva, and ants.


Ants
